WELCOME TO THE COMMUNITY

LOCAL FOOTBALL, LASTING IMPACT

We encourage and champion the participation of over 25 teams within our community aspect of the football club. Ranging from Under 7's to our Women's and Disability Teams, we're proud to offer the opportunity for everyone to participate in the game.

Our dedicated coaches and committee support the safe practice, development and retention across the leagues that our teams are part of, which includes: Suffolk Youth Football League, Ipswich and Suffolk Youth Football League, Colchester and District Youth Football League, Suffolk Girls and Women's Football League, Norfolk Combined Youth Football League, the Wots Up iCAN Football League, Eastern Junior Alliance and Suffolk Disability League.

Venues - Great Whelnetham, St James Bury St Edmunds, Culford Sports Facilities, Bury St Edmunds Rugby Club, the West Suffolk All Weather Pitch and Skyliner Sports Centre.

SUPPORT OUR VENUES

Help us to create safe, welcoming spaces for community football.

We're committed to providing excellent venues for our players, it's at the heart of what we do—they're where teams grow in confidence, friendships are built, and families come together. With your help, we can continue to offer a high-quality, community-focused sporting environment for players of all ages and abilities.

We operate across two key sites: St James and Great Whelnetham, both of which require ongoing maintenance to stay match-ready and welcoming for all. Pitch maintenance at our St James venue alone costs us £10,000 per season.

We Need Support With:

- **Pitch Maintenance** Regular mowing, line marking, surface repairs, and drainage improvements to ensure safe playing conditions.
- Toilet & Changing Facilities Upgrading current facilities to provide more accessible amenities for players and their families.
- **Secure Storage** Safe, weatherproof storage solutions for team kit, goals, and groundskeeping equipment.
- New Catering Unit called a 'The Huddle' at St James- this would offer a kitchen space to improve our facilities and upgrade the match day experience, with the profits reinvested into keeping play going.

Whether you're a local business, tradesperson, or a supporter looking to give back, your support can make a visible difference.
