# SITE GUIDELINES



Welcome to **St James Arena!** To maintain a safe, enjoyable, and respectful atmosphere for all, we kindly ask that visitors follow these guidelines:

## **Parking:**

There are a limited two dozen car parking spaces directly on and around the green next to the venue, and street parking yards away. There is also a pay and display **car park at Ram Meadow** which is a five minute walk.

## **Toilets:**

The closest toilets are **public toilets next to the Ram Meadow car park** or in the **Abbey Gardens** please see map attached. Apologies about the five-minute walk, we currently have a toilet block on order.

## **Pitches:**

Please see map below of our 5, 9 and 11 aside match pitches.

## **Spectators:**

Spectators can watch from behind the respect lines. As a Community Football Club we ask that all visiting supporters encourage and support players in the spirit of the game and refrain from foul and abusive language and behaviour of any kind.

# MATCH PITCHES

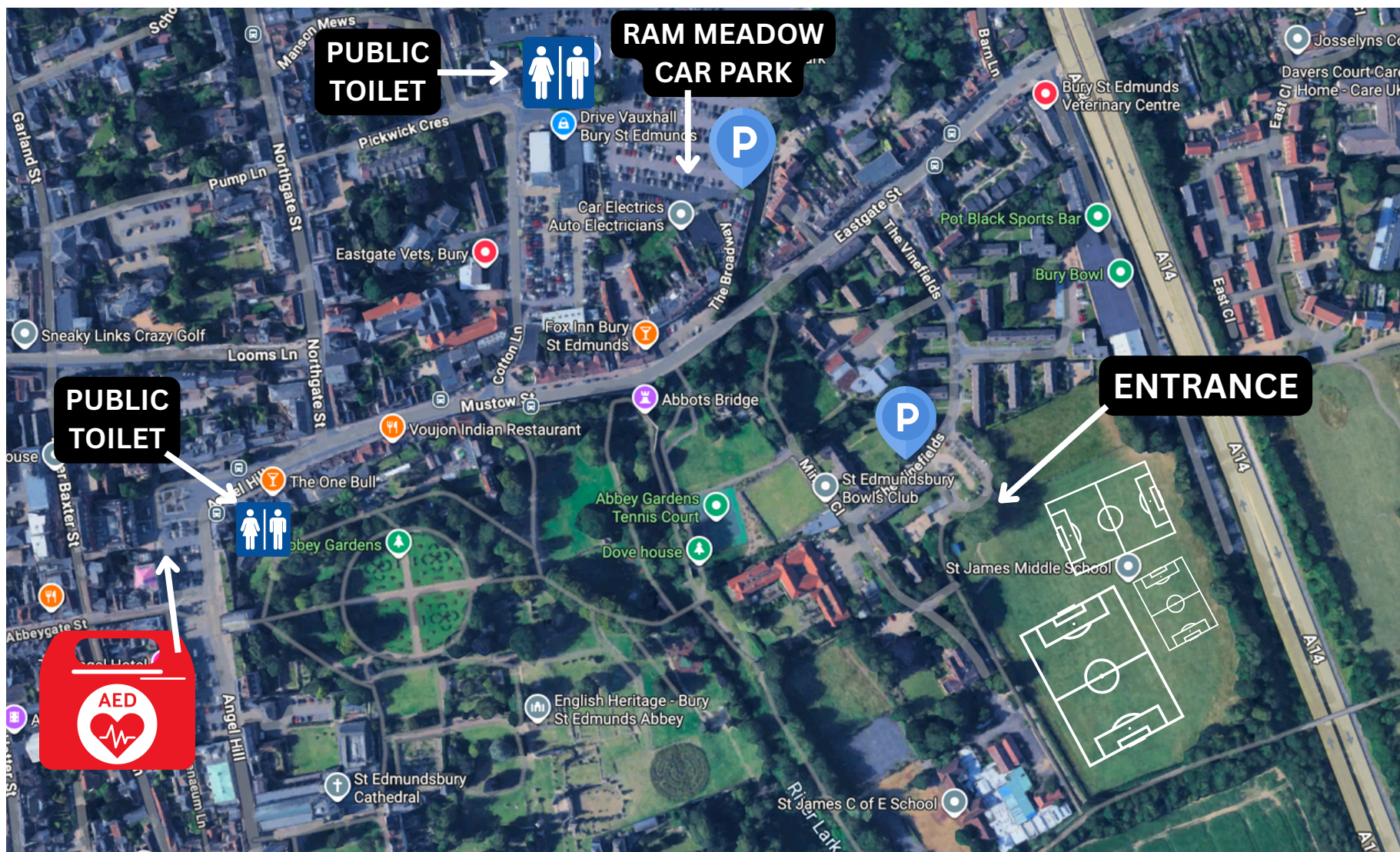


**In order to prevent injuries to players and all players, managers, coaches, officials, and spectators are requested to follow the rules below specifically for this area.**

- **The venue is a non-smoking area. Please do not smoke or vape in the venue.**
- **No glass bottles, cans, food or chewing gum.**
- **Take all personal belongings and litter off the pitch with you.**
- **Make sure all rubbish is removed from the pitch when finishing your match.**
- **Spectators are to remain behind the respect lines at all times.**
- **No spectators should enter the pitch or behind the goal areas.**
- **Only team officials are allowed in the technical areas.**
